In line with Article 10 of the Cultural Heritage Act, the [Malta] Cultural Heritage Strategy (2006) called for the establishment of a National Research Agenda for Cultural Heritage and subsequently followed by the Superintendence of Cultural Heritage through consultations with stakeholders (2010). The Superintendence resumed this initiative in early 2019, and lately commenced on gathering information from practitioners and key researchers at University, MCAST, public entities, the Church and individuals.
