
Property Description

The wash-house was constructed around 1685 by the priest Gasparre Azzopardi, who was in possession of the Tas-Saqqaja benefice and the spring. However some form of arched shelter may have been in existence since the late fourteenth century. This is inferred from a document of 1373 and is partly confirmed by the works carried out in summer of 1597. When running water was unheard of, people from Rabat flocked there for their water supply as well as to wash their clothes. The shelter was very convenient as it shielded the people from the hot sun in summer and from the cold north easterly wind in winter. On the occasion of the building of the wash-house and the channelling of water into stone troughs, three coats of arms were sculpted inside. The middle belongs to Grand Master Gregorio Caraffa (1680–1690); that on its left is of the Azzopardi family, while that on the right is of the Universitas that was responsible for the expenses of its upkeep. The inscription on coralline limestone commemorates the erection of this same wash-house.
