Outline Description	An 18th century chapel built in the Baroque style and dedicated to Our Lady of the Forsaken Souls.
Property Description	The Chapel of Our Lady of Forsaken Souls was built in 1758 to complement the adjacent Villa Buleben estate. Built in the Baroque style the facade is distinctive of the French Rococo style. The chapel architecture reflects the typical arrangement of giant order Ionic pilasters at the end, a continuous entablature, and a broken segmental pediment. The titular painting dating to the same period is in imitation of the one found in Valencia, Spain. The remains of Saint Innocent are retained in this chapel.

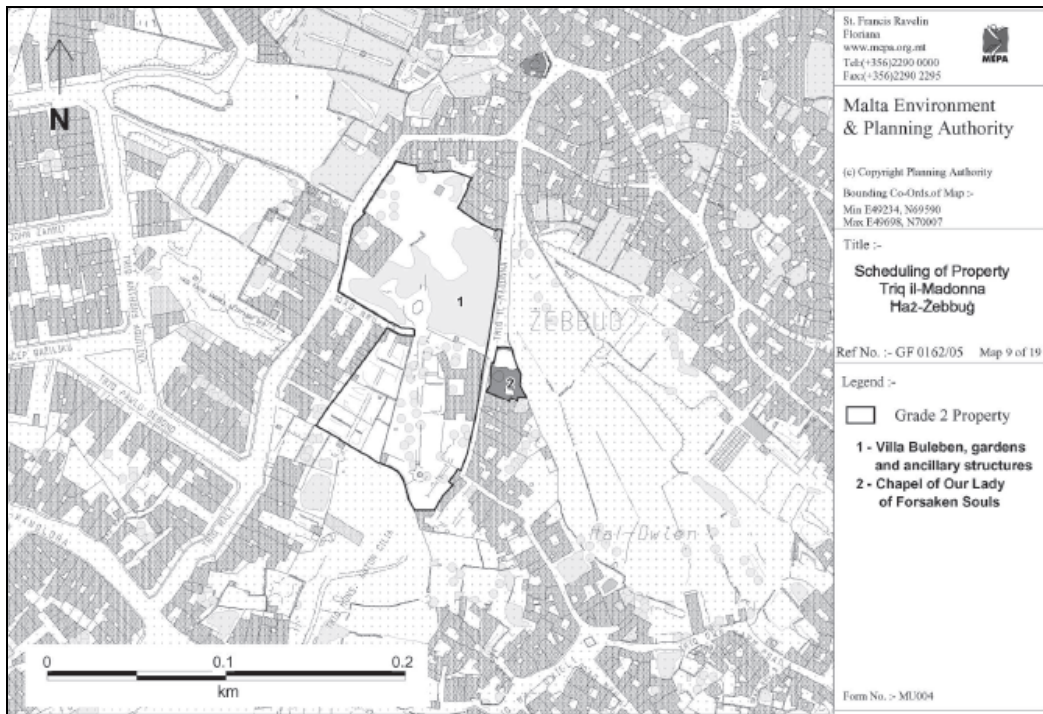
