Outline Description	Medieval Chapel dedicated to Sta. Cecilia
Property Description	<p>Sta. Cecilia chapel is certainly very old dating to around 1540.</p> <p>The chapel is built of stone with front elevation formed in regularised blocks, with the other walls in random stonework. Inside, the chapel is divided into four bays by three slightly pointed arches that spring from the wall piers and carry a shallow pitched stone roof.</p> <p>The chapel has been very recently restored and is taken care of by Wirt Ghawdex.</p>

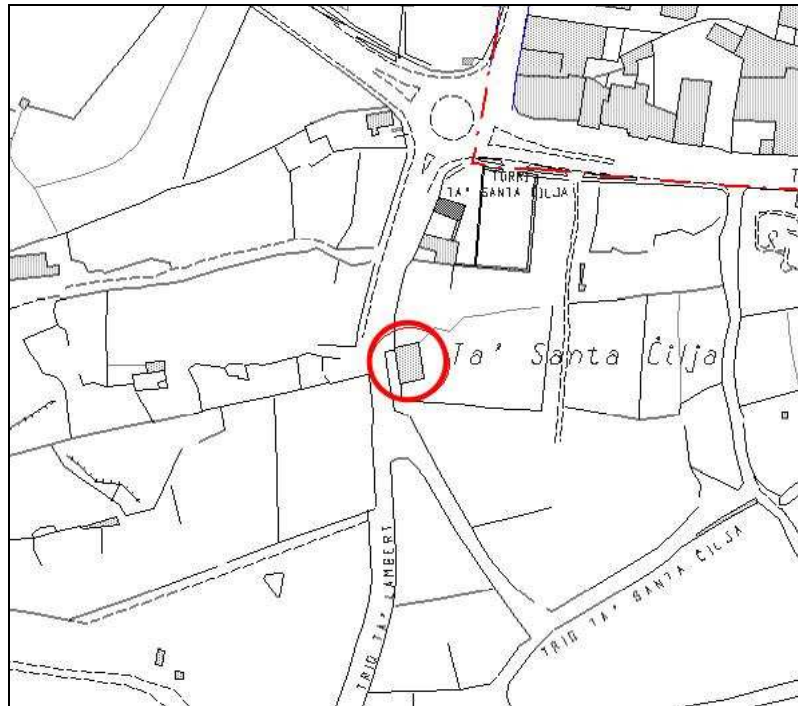
