<b>Outline Description</b>	A small, stone, medieval chapel.
<b>Property Description</b>	This chapel from the 15th century was rebuilt by Gilormu Agius in 1615 in the then Lija jurisdiction. It used to have a cemetery near it and it had a belfry. It stands by itself in the valley and is within the buffer zone of the Lija fireworks factory. It opens only once a year for the feast of St.Michael.

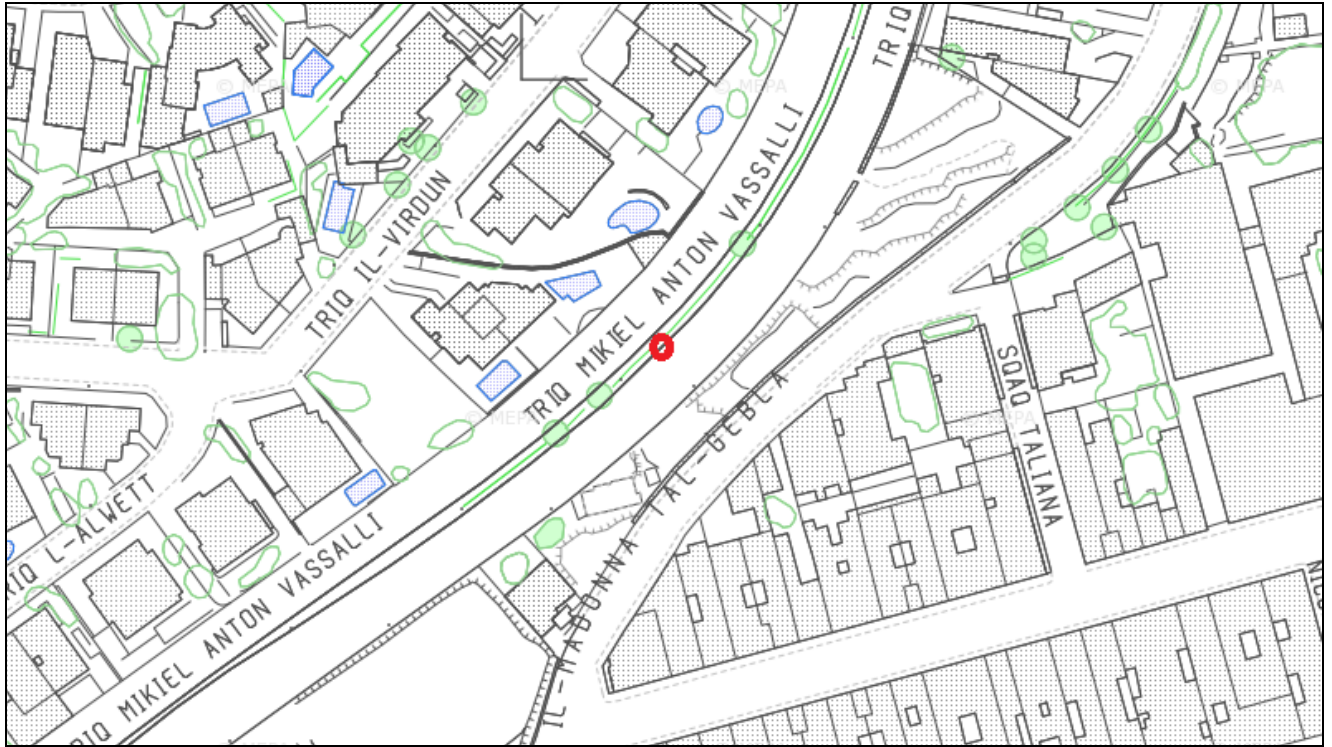
