<b>Outline Description</b>	Governmental School
<b>Property Description</b>	<p>The school was built in 1910, and is the work of architect Andrea Vassallo. The building is massive and there are four streets around the school. In each corner of the four facades there are two tower-like turrets with are decorated with carved Maltese and the English coat of arms. The building is characterised by a verandah-like structure with columns and pilasters running throughout the entire facades of both the ground and first floors in which the classes are set back from the façade.</p>

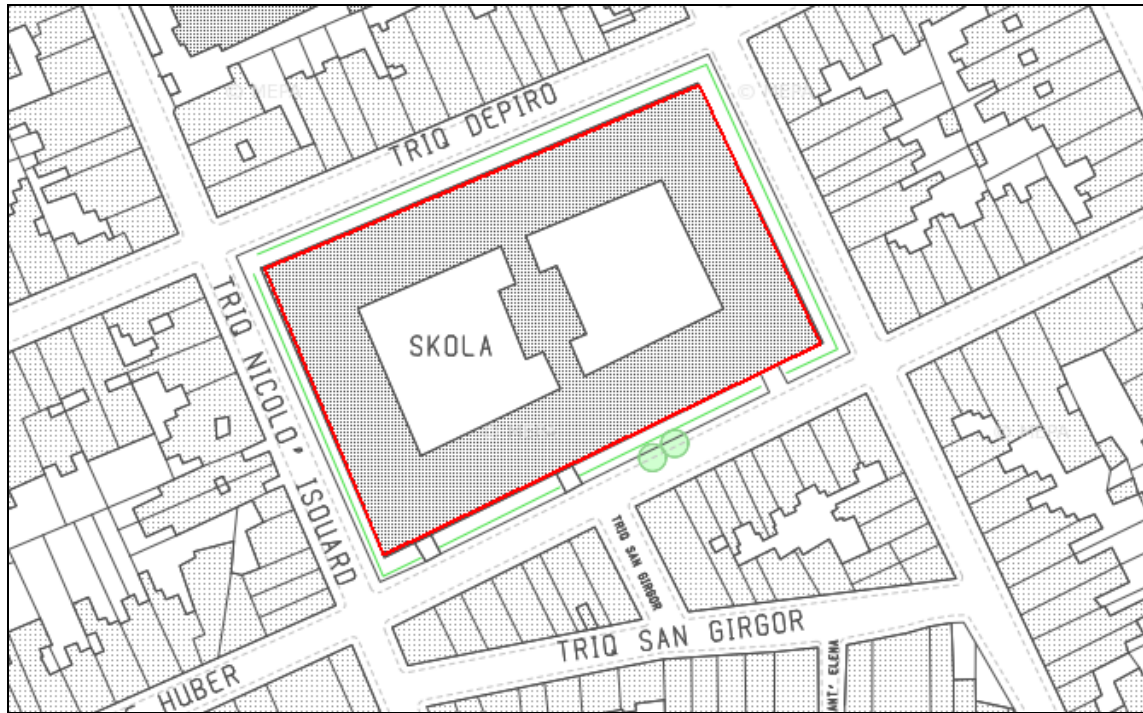
