Outline Description	Residential Villa
Property Description	Built in the 17th century, and originally known as Casa Bondi. The house is a two storey building with a high ceiling at first floor level. The façade is austere and symmetrical. The entrance is through a centrally placed square-headed doorway with a tradition rectangular light window embellished by a pronounced lintel. The doorway is crowned by highly floral decorated carved stone open balcony supported by two massive carved fan shaped corbels. The balcony doorway is embellished by a semicircular pediment. At ground floor level the central doorway is flanked by two vertical windows with a plan moulding and carved sill and lintel overlay two barred doorway shaped panels. Two windows are aligned to those of the ground floor level at first floor. In the latter windows a balustraded parapet wall replaced the window sill, while the above the lintel is decorated by a triangular pediment.

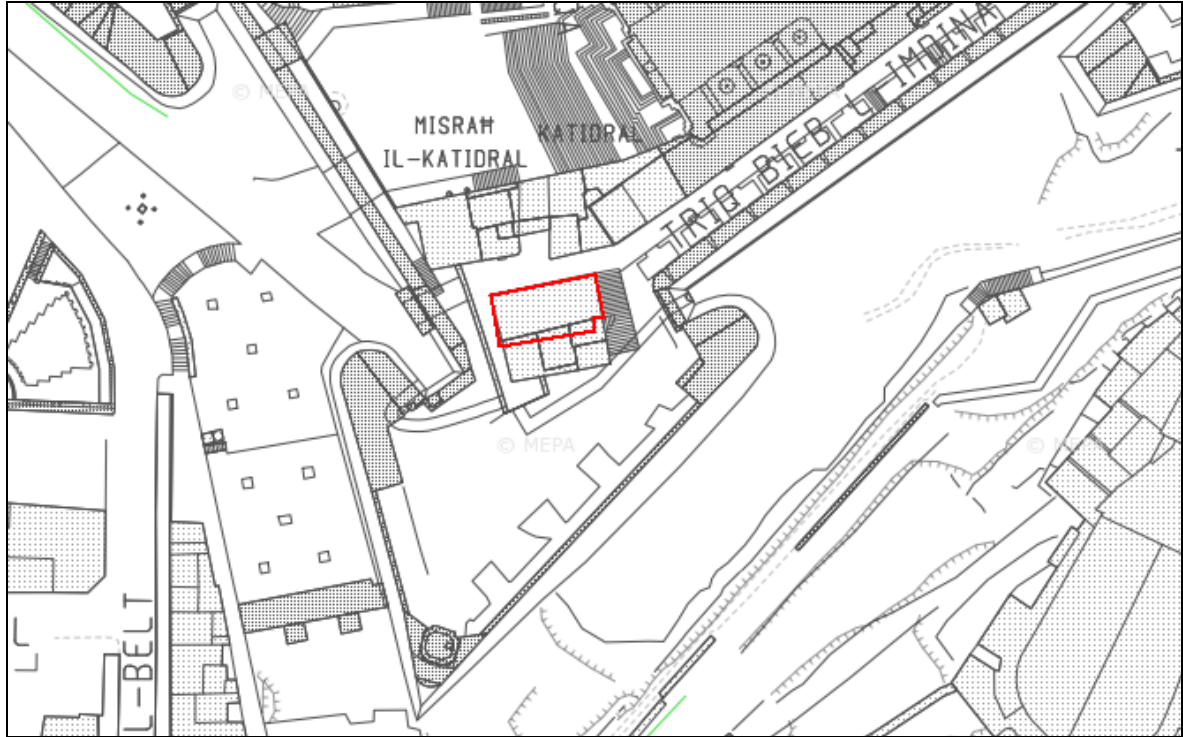
