Outline Description	Chapel dedicated to St Bartholomew
Property Description	The present chapel, built between 1775 and 1784, was built on the site of a previous chapel built in 1482, but was deconsecrated in 1658. The chapel is elevated on a parvise reached by four steps around three sides of the building. The main doorway is centrally placed and flanked on either side by engaged columns. Another set of engaged columns are placed at each corner of the facade which together with the central columns create a recessed panel on either side. Above the main door way is a carved window, under which is a cornice and a hewn masonry work which have not been duly finished and carved. The central part of the facade is headed by a tympanum above the central window. A double cornice runs along the whole chapel.

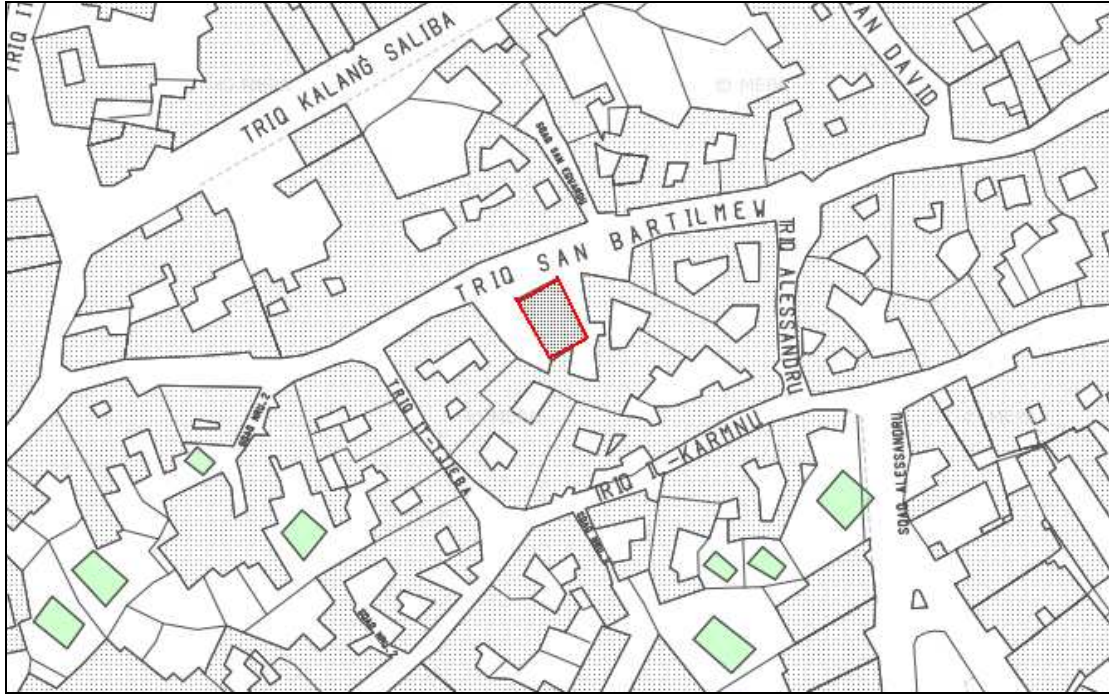
