<b>Outline Description</b>	Chapel dedicated to the Immaculate Conception
<b>Property Description</b>	<p>The 18th century chapel is dedicated to the Immaculate Conception, and is built on a previous chapel dedicated to the Annunciation (which was deconsecrated in 1658). The present chapel was commissioned by the Knight Fra Jacob Togores de Valemuola during the construction of Palace Togores. The chapel was consecrated in 1739. The facade is rather plain, and is characterized by a main bay which protrudes slightly from the rest of the facade. The main bay has a centrally placed doorway which is headed by a semicircular broken cornice which frames a decorative recessed panel which extends above the cornice to form part of the tympanum. A bell -tower is placed on either side of the facade.</p>
