<b>Property Description</b>	The modern church was erected in the 1960s, and is located in Mtahleb. The main entrance, reached through a portico, is characterised by a large rectangular door, flanked by a narrow rectangular side-door on either side. The right wing is a rather plain façade, embellished with a rectangular doorway and three rectangular windows. The left wing of the church is consists of a massive semicircular space. A bell-tower with a rectangular cross plan is placed at the back of the church.

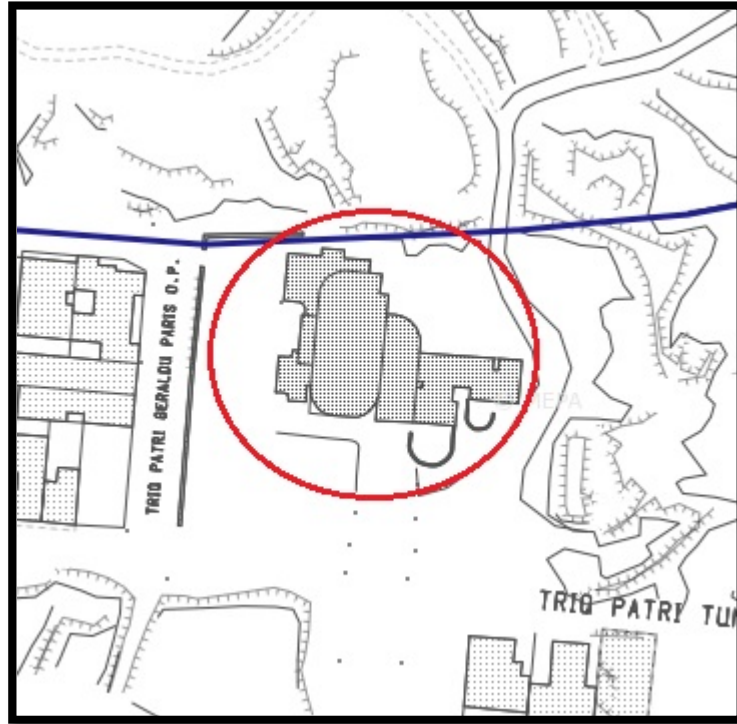
